Tips for Parents

- 1. Encourage your child's involvement in French by ensuring they do their homework and by taking an interest in what they are learning and doing at school each day.
- 2. Keep in close contact with the French teacher to see how your child is progressing.
- 3. Interact with French teachers in a social and academic setting; sponsor regular "get-togethers" such as wine and cheese evenings.
- 4. Consider donating French books and tapes to your child's school.
- 5. Watch French-language television programs and news stories with your child.
- 6. Help older students to obtain summer employment where they might use the French they learned in school (tour guide, nanny to a French family, etc.)
- 7. Attend French film festivals or other cultural activities in your community.
- 8. Enroll your child in French summer camps and student exchanges.
