Speaking other languages and embracing other cultures connects people from around the world.


Lifelong Learning • • • • •

Second language study benefits academic progress in other subjects. (Curtain & Dahlberg 2004); Second language study narrows achievement gaps. (Dumas 1999); Second Language study benefits basic skills development. (Garfinkle and Tabor 1991); Early second language learning enriches and enhances cognitive development. (Curtain and Dahlberg 2004); Second language study enhances a student's sense of achievement. (Marsciantonio 1977, Saunders 1998, Andrade, et al. 1989); Second language students score higher on standardized tests. (College Board 2003); Second language study promotes cultural awareness and competency. 
